Structure of Student Council

StuCo Faculty Advisors

- Position held by one or two full-time teacher(s) who provide guidance and advice to the Student Council.
- Attend all council meetings and approve decisions made by the Executive Council.
- Responsible for addressing concerns with the students and administration as needed and obtaining administrative approval for various matters.

StuCo Executive Council

- **President:** Assists the administration in leading the school and managing student affairs and engagement.
- **Vice President:** Assists the President with various tasks and promotes school spirit.
- **Secretary:** Takes meeting minutes and manages various administrative duties for the Executive Council. Also responsible for creating and managing Student Council schedules and meetings.
- **Officer of Student Connections:** Leads Hangouts and the Group Mentors to foster connections among the student body.
- **Officer of Student Organizations:** Collaborates with the Faculty Advisor(s) to oversee clubs, the Swag Shop, and the Yearbook.
- **Officer of Student Opportunities:** Assists the Peer Mentors in implementing the badging and meeting programs. Also, leads school-wide events, helps with EFFs, runs school-wide programs, and upholds the BYU OHS mission.

- Assist the Vice President in coordinating Spirit Week activities.
- Organize semester Talent Shows.
- Encourage student participation in various clubs.

StuCo Organizations

- **Group Mentors:** Leads groups during Hangouts.
- **Club Leaders:** Leads clubs and provides support to the Faculty Advisor(s).
- **Swag Shop:** Collaborates with the school secretaries to promote the shop and generates ideas for merchandise.
- **Yearbook Staff:** Collects memories and items throughout the school year for publication in the Yearbook.
- **Discussion Monitor:** Monitors the discussion boards and reports any misconduct to the Faculty Advisor(s).
- **Outreach (Everybody's Best Friend):** Works towards building friendships with students to foster engagement and inclusivity.
- **Spiritual Activities Coordinator:** Sends out spiritual and positive thoughts and motivation to the student body.

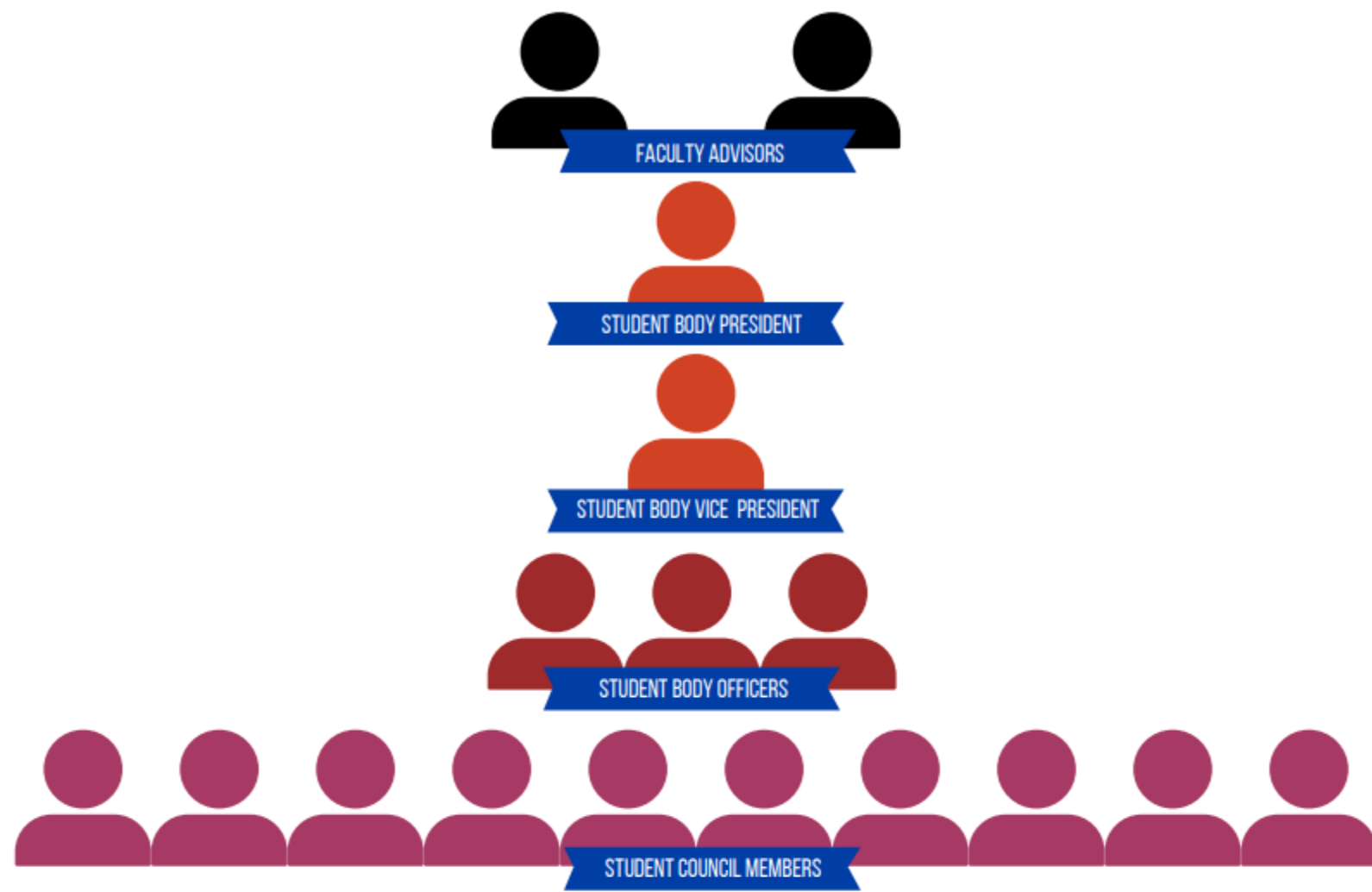

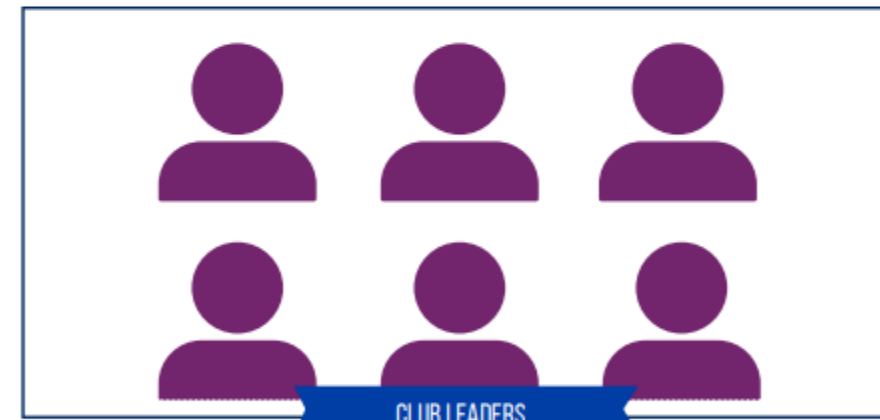
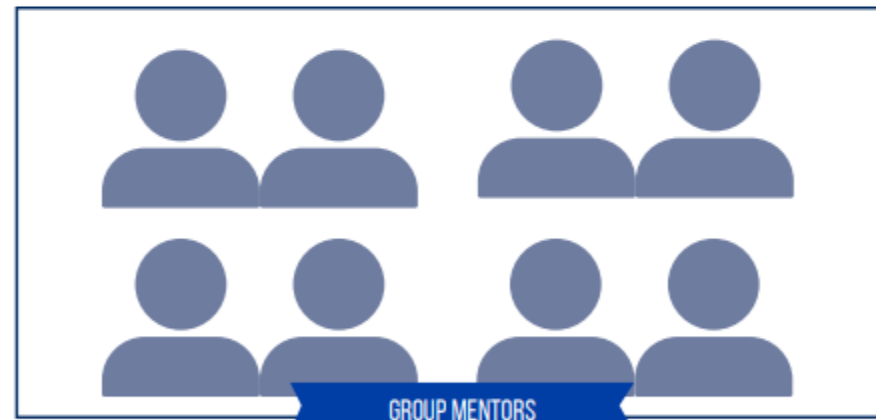

Expectations of Members



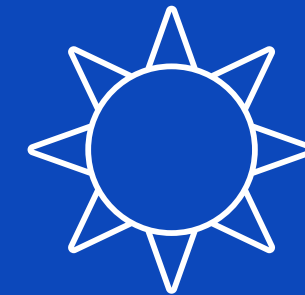
Kindness

Sign!

All members of the Student Council are required to adhere to the following expectations. Failure to comply with these expectations may result in expulsion from the Student Council. The school administration will have the final authority over all decisions made by the Student Council.

- Student Council members are expected to demonstrate **KINDNESS** and professionalism in all their interactions with fellow students, faculty, and administration. This includes no bullying, talking negatively about others, or saying anything rude or inappropriate to or about others.
- Student Council members are expected to fulfill their role with **RESPECT** and act responsibly in all forms of communication, assignments, and classes, serving as role models for other students in our program. This includes respecting other students' opinions, even if they differ from your own, respecting what your leaders tell you, and accepting warnings and stopping inappropriate behavior.
- Student Council members are expected to put forth the necessary **EFFORT** and responsibility, meeting the expectations set by other council members and the administration. This includes attending all/most meetings, responding to texts/emails, fulfilling your assignments to the best of your abilities, and keeping up with your school work.
